The workshop addresses young researchers from the participating universities in all areas of applied economic research. Graduate students, postdocs and junior professors have the opportunity to present their work and to network. The workshop will contain both, oral presentation and a poster session with short pitches in plenum.

A highlight will be two keynote sessions: We are happy that **Clément de Chaisemartin (Sciences Po, Paris)** will provide insights about state-of-the-art causal identification. **Olaf Lies (Minister for Economic Affairs of Lower Saxony)** will share his experiences with economic policy and its challenges in practice.

Presenters have the chance to be awarded with the **Best Paper Award (500 Euros)** or the **Best Poster Award (250 Euros)**.

The workshop will be held in English. All presentations and posters will be accompanied by a discussion, and we expect all participants to take on a discussion. Travel and accommodation costs will be covered for accepted presenters (both oral and posters).

All those interested are cordially invited to attend the workshop, even without presentation (registration required). Participation is free of charge.
