Courses and Credits

Campus	Kasetsart University, Bangkhen Campus
Courses	Exchange students may choose courses of their interest outside of their host faculty. However, students must be responsible in : 1. Contacting the other faculty in which their chosen courses are offered. This includes acquiring approval to attend said courses/classes. 2. Communicating with their home universities regarding applicable transfer of credits etc. This applies to all of their chosen courses whether or not outside of their host faculty.
Credits	15 to 18 credit hours (5 to 6 classes). Per semester is generally 15 weeks of instruction with 3 credit hours per class, not including midterm and final examinations and projects. Note: 1 KU credit is approximately equal to 2 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System)



Nomination and Application



Nomination

The home institutions will select qualified students and nominations must be directed to the KU International Affairs Division (IAD) via iad@ku.th.



Application

Nominated students must complete the application form via the online system.



Online Application

Applications will be sent to their selected host faculty for final consideration.



Acceptance

The IAD office will send an official Letter of Acceptance to the home institution and the documents necessary to apply for a student visa.



Visa Requirements

After receiving the official Letter of Acceptance (LOA) from Kasetsart University, students must apply at the Royal Thai Embassy or Consulate in their respective countries for a Non-Immigrant ED visa (student visa) to enter Thailand.

International students are not permitted to pursue studies at Kasetsart University with a Tourist Visa (or any other type of visa).

**In the case, the Consulate may require the original copy of the LOA, students must contact and inform Ms. Wanida Kammani (fecowdka@ku.ac.th) or the IAD office (iad@ku.th) at the earliest convenience.



Health Insurance

International students must have a health insurance covering the duration of their study period. If an international student does not have sufficient health insurance coverage, the students must purchase additional health insurance plan. Students must contact the KUIC (Kasetsart University International College) upon arrival to do so.

The KU approved health plan costs 8,500 Thai baht per year.
