The summer school "Quantitative Finance" is your chance to study **modern technologies** used in **finance**. The program is cut out for international students whose major is finance, economics and business.

The theoretical block is called "**Portfolio Theory** and Asset Management" and implemented by professors from **City, University of London**, one of the leading universities in Europe. Having mastered this module, you will gain invaluable insights into key business and finance knowledge and skills.

The practical block is offered to choose from **Matlab programming for finance** or **modeling in Stata software package.** This block is implemented by professors from **City, University of London** and **SPbPU.** Interactive training methods, field trips and group discussions are used to activate students' involvement.

For successful mastery of the practical block, students do not need special skills in MatLab programming or Stata modeling.
