Academic year

The academic year begins end of September and runs until early July. It consists of two semesters, each comprising 13 weeks of instruction, an examination period and a holiday period. There are two periods of examinations (January and June). Students who have not passed these first exams get a second chance during the second examination period (August).

A normal workload for 1 semester is 30 ECTS credits. We expect incoming students to take at least 20 ECTS credits. The deadline for nomination is October 15th for the spring semester and April 15th for the autumn semester.

Language requirements

Courses are offered in Dutch and English. Students have to prove proficiency in English by submitting one of the following language certificates:

- ITACE, FCE, Erasmus+: minimum level B2
- TOEFL: minimum score 80
- IELTS: minimum score 6.5

Additionally, students can prove proficiency if they obtained at least 60 ECTS credits in an English-language bachelor or master programme. The board of admission may still ask for additional proof, demonstrated by a language certificate.
