GRADING SYSTEM	 The Hungarian system of assessment consists of a five-point grading scale. These are as follows: Excellent (5) Good (4) Satisfactory (3) Pass (2) Fail (1) One academic year consists of two terms (autumn & spring semesters) which can be further divided into 3 further periods such as registration, term-time (lecture period), and exam period. Registration: the student can finalize his/her schedule, enroll for the upcoming term, and take part in orientation days. Duration of the registration: 1 week Duration of the exam-time: 6 weeks (at least 28 working days)
