SAT scores are require for admission to some degree programs.

Requirement:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Enrolled as a degree student in home university ❖ Photocopy of passport ❖ A scanned copy of official transcript of records of your current degree with the degree name and level ❖ A scanned copy of original degree certificate and complete transcript of Bachelor's with authorized English translation (for Master applicant) ❖ A scanned copy of original degree certificate and complete transcript of Bachelor's and Master's with authorized English translation (for PhD applicant) ❖ If not a native English speaker, proof of English proficiency Test or other assessment provided in Nomination Letter ❖ Students must obtain the non-immigrant Thai ED-Visa to study in Thailand ❖ Proof of Medical/Health insurance coverage for duration of studies ❖ Nomination Letter from the home university ❖ Scanned copy of certified scholarship award letter (if applicable) <p style="text-align: center;">- NOTE -</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All of the documents must be in English and need to be certified copies of the originals. Documents that are not in English must be accompanied by certified English translations. - An official transcript issued by the institution you graduated from must be a complete version clarifying a record of all courses you have taken in each academic semester along with the date of graduation, credits, and grades. - If your degree certificate does not clearly state the name and the level of your degree, you will need a certifying letter from your university to confirm that your degree is equivalent to a bachelor's degree or master's degree. - You must submit all the completed application documents at least 3 months before the semester starts. <p>Please find more information from https://iad.intaff.ku.ac.th/wordpress/?page_id=17444</p>

Duration of Exchange	<p>An Exchange student is permitted to spend the exchange period at Kasetsart University not more than 2 semester as specified in the university bilateral agreement.</p>

Visa Regulations: Do students need a visa upon their arrival?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Please apply from your home country at a Thai Embassy or Consulate. ➤ The THAILAND Non-immigrant ED-Visa is required to study. ➤ Students who arrive without the ED-Visa may seek assistance from the ISC Office.
Health Insurance:	<p>**All international students must have Medical/Health and Accident Insurance covering the duration of their studies in Thailand. If students do not have health insurance prior to arrival, they must apply at the International Studies Center (ISC) immediately upon arrival (est. 8,500 THB per year).</p>

<p>Letter of Acceptance or Letter of Invitation / Thai Education (ED) Visa Application:</p>	<p>If the Exchange Student's Application is ACCEPTED, International Affairs Division (IAD) will send to you a formal Letter of Acceptance and a cover letter to the Thai Embassy/Thai Consulate that you choose to apply for a visa in your country via the application system at https://iad-database.intaff.ku.ac.th/portal/KU_eService/application_check_status.php</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This letter is VERY IMPORTANT for your Thai Education (ED) Visa Application. • Because it may take several days to gain your Thai ED visa, it is a good idea to submit your Application, and if admitted, to receive your Letter of Acceptance or Letter of Invitation, as early as possible. • Information about the Thai ED Visa application (for exchange students) can be found at http://bit.ly/2BVlwk0 <p style="text-align: center;">-NOTE-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To apply for your Thai Education (ED) Visa, research the application rules for the documents, fees, and timelines required by the Thai Consulate or Embassy. • The requirements are NOT the same at every consulate. <p>DOES YOUR CONSULATE REQUIRE ORIGINAL OR SCANNED - NOTE THE FOLLOWING:</p> <p>- Do you need an ORIGINAL Letter of Acceptance sent by international mail? OR, is a SCANNED Letter of Acceptance sent to you via email sufficient?</p> <p><i>Please note that IAD will only send the scan of letter to you via the application system .The program coordinator is the person who take care of the ORIGINAL letter sending and they will send the ORIGINAL one to you by international mail only if REQUIRED by the Thai Consulate or Embassy. It takes longer to arrive so plan accordingly.</i></p>
<p>Guidelines for New Students</p>	<p>International Studies Center (ISC) is the administrative office that coordinates international education activities, offers cultural training, assists with Visa extensions, and generally advises and facilitates visiting International Students. ISC is located in the Rapee Sagarik Building, (Office of the Registrar) on the 6th floor.</p> <p><i>***Exchange Students must visit the ISC Office on your first arrival day to register officially as a Kasetsart University Student.***</i></p>
<p>Student ID Card</p>	<p>In order to make your Student ID Card, you need to wear proper student uniform (for undergraduate students only).</p> <p>For undergraduate students: Please contact International Studies Center (ISC) at Rapee Sagarik Building</p> <p>For graduate students: Please contact Graduate School at Graduate School Building</p> <p style="text-align: center;">During mid-term and final examination period, students must show their Student ID Card to enter examination room.</p>
<p>Registration Process</p>	<p>Exchange students must submit the KU1 Form (Course Registration Form) to the Faculty. KU1 Form can be downloaded on http://registrar.ku.ac.th/download/ku1-registration-form/ or can be received at International Studies Center (ISC).</p>
<p>Transcripts</p>	<p>All exchange students can download their online transcript after the semester ends at https://inter-regis.ku.ac.th/Login.php. For those who need an original transcript please contact the program coordinator before go back to your home university.</p>
<p>Estimated Living Expenses:</p>	<p>Approximately 15,000-20,000 THB per month (5 months per semester)</p>
