	- Do you need an <b>ORIGINAL</b> Letter of Acceptance sent by international mail?
	OR, is a <b>SCANNED</b> Letter of Acceptance sent to you via email sufficient?
	Please note that IAD will only send the scan of letter to you via the application
	system .The program coordinator is the person who take care of the ORIGINAL letter
	sending and they will send the ORIGINAL one to you by international mail only if
